Electronic games; CD or MP3 player; candy.

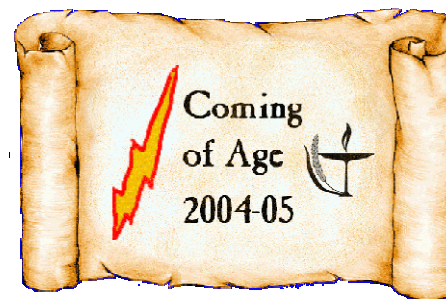
## Carpooling

## How to get to Shekinah Retreat Centre

Allow an hour's drive from Saskatoon. See map on back page. Links to a **road map** and a **site map** are located at [www.ucsaskatoon.org/coa/shekinah-retreat-timetable.html](http://www.ucsaskatoon.org/coa/shekinah-retreat-timetable.html) Travel straight north on Highway 12 from Saskatoon, turning right at the Shekinah roadsign just north of the town of Hepburn. Follow this grid road turning left at the correction line and right again at the next available turn (about 1/4 kilometre). Continue north until you reach Shekinah. We will be staying at The Hermitage (near the centre of the site map).
